The Gifts

GOBeyond Charities is a non-profit corporation dedicated to spreading the warm spirit of giving throughout the year and especially during the holiday season. For 45 years, our Annual Christmas Benefit Gala has provided gifts for thousands of needy children in the Atlanta area who have little else to look forward to during the holiday season. The gift lists are compiled from the requests of local churches, family organizations, and charity members.

As a charitable organization we believe in the power of direct personal involvement. It is the primary means by which we seek to help others in our community overcome the tragic consequences of sickness, poverty and physical abuse.

We know our charitable deeds really do make a difference, because we make it a point to understand the specific needs of those we help. We constantly seek out deserving individuals, families and institutions - especially those too often overlooked by government, social services and other charitable agencies. Then we find innovative ways to get involved. Sometimes it's providing badly needed items like a winter coat for an unemployed father who has to go out and find work to support his family. Sometimes it's helping a single mother in a shelter for battered women pay for a critical operation for her child. Or, it can simply be playing Santa to underprivileged kids at Christmas. But always it's finding a way to make it a meaningful difference in peoples' lives.

Shriners Hospitals for Children

Shriners Hospitals for Children is a network of 22 medical facilities across North America that treats children with orthopedic conditions, burns, spinal cord injuries, and cleft lips and palates. All services are provided in a family-centered environment, regardless of the patients' ability to pay.

- Three of the hospitals provide spinal cord injury rehabilitation with adventure and adapted sports programs, activity-based rehabilitation, aquatherapy, animal-assisted therapy, and other innovative programs
- Four of the hospitals (Boston, Galveston, Cincinnati, and Sacramento) provide world-famous care for children with burns, as well as treating a variety of skin conditions
- The Boston, Chicago, Shreveport, and Portland hospitals also provide treatment for children with craniofacial conditions, especially facial clefts.
- The hospital in Sacramento is the only hospital in the Shriners' system that focuses on all three areas of treatment (burns, orthopedics, and spinal cord injuries), as well as research.

Children accepted for treatment become part of the Shriners Hospital system until their 18th or, sometimes, their 21st, birthday, eligible for both inpatient and outpatient treatment for all facets of their disability.

While the overwhelming emphasis of the hospitals is to provide medical care to children regardless of the family's ability to pay, the mission of the hospitals also includes research on the conditions treated and the education of medical professionals.

Hagar's House Emergency Shelter and Assessment Center

Hager's House is an emergency night shelter and assessment center with support services for women and children. The shelter offers at least 30 nights of short-term housing and has room for up to 30 guests. While participating in the program, families receive thorough assessment and crisis intervention, two meals a day, laundry facilities, MARTA fares, computer training opportunities, employment counseling, a support group, and referrals to other services, such as free child care, legal assistance, and health care.

Family House Transitional Program

Family House provides housing and support services to move families from homelessness to self-reliance in about 6 months. The program uses single-family houses and apartments throughout DeKalb County. Both single- and two-parent families can apply, and hard-to-place families, including those headed by single fathers or with teenage boys, are welcome. While participating in the program, families receive:

- Housing & Utilities
- Case Management & Counseling
- Financial management classes
- A savings plan
- Computer Training opportunities
- Referrals for child care, legal assistance, health care

Family House residents put 30% of their adjusted income into an account with DCM. At the end of their participation in the program, all but 10% is returned to the family as savings. The money can be used for rent, security and utility deposits, and moving expenses.

S.H.A.R.E. House

Someone **H**elping **A**nother through **R**esources and **E**ducation

Share House Douglas is a non-profit organization providing crisis intervention and continuum of care to address the causes and effects of family violence. Our goal is to bring a sense of order and stability into the lives of women and children, and reduce future risks of victimization and displacement. Over 50 families, including 130 children, receive support due to your generosity.

Sheltering Grace Ministry

Sheltering Grace Ministry (SGM) takes an “**Ownership, Accountability and Responsibility**” approach to the services we provide. Sheltering Grace Ministry is not a shelter that just provides a home for the pregnant homeless, but a complete program to guide these mothers to a better understanding of how to make successful life choices and changes. The SGM program is designed as a holistic approach for long-term success through education, life skills coaching, spiritual and emotional healing.

SGM is committed to our participant’s success and growth. The program requires that they complete a **12 Step Healing Program** and that they draw upon their inner strength and power of the Holy Spirit to make the changes needed to truly move their lives forward in a positive way.

The successful completion of the SGM program transforms the lives of our mothers. They are now able to manage and sustain all areas of their life, reaching their goal of independent living and in doing so; they break the generational cycle of dysfunctional living.

SGM answers over 900 crisis calls from social workers, ministries, and individuals every year. The need is everywhere. We recognize that SGM is only able to help a few of those in need, but for those who qualify, their way with us impacts both their and their baby’s life for eternity.
